

Agreement

The Political Science Doctoral School of Corvinus University and the School of Political Science, Public Policy and International Relations of Central European University are committed to intensify cooperation and coordination in order to improve political science education and research. As part of these efforts the two Schools agree on the following

1. The students of the Corvinus Political Science Doctoral School receive free entrance to the CEU library. Students of the Political Science Doctoral Program at CEU also receive free entrance to the Corvinus Library. Borrowing privileges will be the subject of further arrangements.
2. The students of the Corvinus Political Science Doctoral School can participate, in limited numbers, at the yearly conferences of the CEU Political Science Doctoral Program and at the Doctoral Seminars. The students of CEU are invited to the biannual Corvinus Doctoral Research Fora.
3. The doctoral students of the two Schools can visit, in limited number, courses taught within the other School's program. Visiting students can register courses only for audit. The curricula of both programs will be announced in advance to the respective student bodies. The leadership of the two doctoral programs must endorse the selection of the visiting students.
4. CEU Political Science Doctoral Program students can participate in the teaching at the Corvinus Political Science Institute and Doctoral School. Their participation can take the form of independent teaching or of teaching assistantship, depending on their skills and the needs of the Corvinus programs. Corvinus Doctoral students will be occasionally invited to present and/or teach within the M.A. program of CEU's Political Science Department. The leadership of the two doctoral programs will agree on the number of teaching positions on an annual basis and must endorse the selection of teaching staff.
5. Corvinus University nostrifies CEU Political Science PhD's through a fast-track procedure if the dissertation fits the requirements of the Corvinus Doctoral program.
6. The two Schools are committed to integrate the political science research efforts carried out at the two universities.
7. After two years of entering in force, the agreement can be subject to revisions, if one of the partners or both find this desirable.
